## Usage

The infobox may be added by pasting the template as shown below into an article and then filling in the desired fields. Any parameters left blank or omitted will not be displayed.

## Parameters

Do not use all these parameters for any one person. The list is long to cover a wide range of people. Only use those parameters that convey essential or notable information about the subject. Any parameters left blank or omitted will not be displayed. If a data field has more than one parameter name which can be used, the preferred name is listed first in **bold** print.

Parameter	Explanation
<b>name</b>	Common name of person (defaults to article name if left blank; provide <b>birth_name</b> (below) if different from <b>name</b> ).
<b>image</b>	Image name
<b>image_size</b> ( <i>imagesize</i> )	Size to display image: <i>200px</i> (set width), or <i>200x300px</i> (max width & max height). This defaults to 225px if empty or omitted.
<b>alt</b>	Alt text for image, for visually impaired readers.
<b>caption</b>	Caption for image, if needed. Try to include date of photo and the photographer.
<b>birth_name</b>	Name at birth, if different from <b>name</b> .
<b>birth_date</b>	Date of birth: <span>{{birth date and age 1930 1 15}}</span> (if living) or <span>{{birth date 1930 1 15}}</span> (if dead). See <a href="#">Template:Birth date</a> for details.

<b>birth_place</b>	Place of birth: city, administrative region, sovereign state.
<b>death_date</b>	Date of death: {{death date and age 1995 10 9 1930 1 15}} (if birth date is known) or {{death date 1995 10 9}} (if birth date unknown).
<b>death_place</b>	Place of death: city, administrative region, sovereign state.
<b>body_discovered</b>	Place where the body was discovered (If different from place of death).
<b>death_cause</b>	Cause of death.
<b>resting_place</b>	Place of burial, ash-scattering, etc.
<b>resting_place_coordinates</b>	Coordinates for place of burial, ash-scattering etc.
<b>residence</b>	Location(s) where the person notably resides/resided, if different from birth place.
<b>nationality</b>	Nationality. May be used instead of citizenship (below) or vice versa in cases where any confusion could result. Should only be used <i>with</i> citizenship when they somehow differ.
<b>ethnicity</b>	Ethnicity.
<b>citizenship</b>	Citizenship. <i>See usage notes for nationality.</i>
<b>other_names</b>	Other notable names for the person, if different from <b>name</b> and <b>birth_name</b> .
<b>known_for</b> </br> ( <i>known</i> )	A brief description of why the person is notable.
<b>education</b>	Education.
<b>alma_mater</b>	Alma mater
<b>employer</b>	Employer.
<b>occupation</b>	Occupation.
<b>home_town</b>	The place where the person was raised and matured, if different from birth place and residence.
<b>salary</b>	Annual salary or compensation.
<b>networth</b>	Current estimated net worth.
<b>height</b>	If person was notable for their height.
<b>weight</b>	If used, this should also include the date.
<b>title</b>	
<b>term</b>	Years the person held the <b>title</b> listed above.
<b>predecessor</b>	Person who previously held the <b>title</b> listed above.
<b>successor</b>	Person who subsequently held the <b>title</b> listed above.
<b>party</b>	Field labeled <b>Political party</b> .
<b>boards</b>	Field labeled <b>Board member of</b> .
<b>religion</b>	Field labeled <b>Religion</b> .
<b>spouse</b>	Name of spouse(s), followed by years of marriage. Use the format <i>Name (1950-present)</i> for current spouse and <i>Name (1970-1999)</i> for former spouse(s). Separate entries with a line break ( ).
<b>partner</b>	Use same format as <b>spouse</b> .
<b>children</b>	Number of children (i.e. 3), or list of names if notable. Separate entries with a line break ( ).
<b>parents</b>	Names of parents, if notable. Separate entries with a line break ( ).
<b>relatives</b> ( <i>relations</i> )	Names of siblings or other relatives, if notable. Include the relationship in parentheses after the name (sister, uncle, etc). Separate entries with a line break ( ).

<b>callsign</b>	Amateur radio <b>call-sign</b> .
<b>awards</b>	Notable awards
<b>signature</b>	An image of the person's signature.
<b>signature_alt</b>	Alt text for the signature image.
<b>website</b>	Official website only. Unofficial websites should be placed under <span>==External links==</span> in the body of the article.
<b>footnotes</b>	Notes about any of the infobox data.
<b>box_width</b>	The infobox width, such as: <span>box_width=220px</span> (default: 22em). Space character between the number and the unit of measurement breaks the parameter.
