The source text will not be altered (copying/pasting the text will be presented in its original form), only in its browser display. You can use this template to control the display of the variable output of magic words and of other templates.

## Example

Code

```

Result

thE *NaMe* oF thE GAME

## Note

**Substitution (subst :)** of this template is **not recommended**. The result will *not* create lower case source text but only an appearance there of; the original text will wrapped in an HTML tag in the page source. Because of this, it would be more effective to simply edit the original text as lower case.
