Parameters

No parameters are required unless {{navbar}} links ("v·d·e") are to appear at the bottom of the sidebar, in which case the parameter *name* is needed (see entry in the table immediately below).

Principal

Parameter	Explanation		
<i>name</i>	The sidebar's name, i.e. the name following "Template:" in the page's name. Required for the {{navbar}} links at the bottom of the sidebar to function correctly, unless these are omitted (see <i>navbar</i> at the bottom of this table).		
<i>outertitle</i>	Use to place a title for the sidebar immediately above the sidebar.		
<i>topimage</i>	Use to place an image at the top of the sidebar, i.e. above any <i>title</i> included. Full wikisyntax expected (i.e. [[Image: ...]]). To add a caption below the image, use <i>topimagecaption</i> .		
<i>pretitle</i>	Use to place a line such as "Part of the X series on" before the title.		
<i>title</i>	Use to place a title for the sidebar at the top of the sidebar (immediately below the <i>topimage</i> , if used).		
<i>image</i>	Use to place an image between the <i>title</i> (if used) and first section. As with <i>topimage</i> , full wikisyntax expected (i.e. [[Image: ...]]). To add a caption below the image, use <i>imagecaption</i> .		
<i>headingstyle</i>	Use to alter the default CSS styling set for section headings. To alter the CSS styling for a specific section's heading, use <i>headingNstyle</i> , where <i>N</i> is the number of the section.		
<i>contentstyle</i>	Use to alter the default CSS styling set for section content. To alter the CSS styling for a particular section's content, use <i>contentNstyle</i> , where <i>N</i> is the number of the section.		
<i>heading1</i>	First section's heading (if needed).</tr>	<i>content1</i>	First section's content (required).</tr>
<i>heading2</i>	Second section's heading (if needed).</tr>	<i>content2</i>	Second section's content (if needed).</tr>

<i>heading3</i>	Third section's heading (if needed).</tr>	<i>content3</i>	Third section's content (if needed).</tr>
..... etc			
<i>heading35</i>		<i>content35</i>	
<i>navbar</i>	Currently, the last possible section heading and/or content (if needed).</tr>		Set to "none" (without the quotes) to remove the {{ navbar }} links appearing at the bottom of the sidebar.

Other parameters

Parameter	Explanation
<i>above</i>	Corresponds to <i>above</i> parameter offered by {{ Navbar }}.
<i>class</i> (or <i>bodyclass</i>)	
<i>outertitleclass</i>	Microformat classes for the corresponding parameters.
<i>topimageclass</i>	(<i>class / bodyclass</i> applies to the sidebar as a whole.)
<i>titleclass</i>	
<i>imageclass</i>	
<i>below</i>	Use to e.g. add one or more portal links to the bottom of the template (by default in bold).
<i>style</i> (or <i>bodystyle</i>)	
<i>outertitlestyle</i>	
<i>topimagestyle</i>	
<i>topcaptionstyle</i>	
<i>pretitestyle</i>	Use to alter default CSS styling for the corresponding parameters.
<i>titestyle</i>	(<i>style / bodystyle</i> applies to the sidebar as a whole.)
<i>imagestyle</i>	
<i>captionstyle</i>	
<i>belowstyle</i>	
<i>navbarstyle</i>	
<i>cellspacing</i>	Use to amend the default cellspacing set for the infobox-class table with which the sidebar is built.
<i>cellpadding</i>	Ditto the default cellpadding.
<i>navbaroptions</i>	Use to specify more options for the navbar at the bottom of the sidebar (see {{ navbar }} for options available).
